MAIN CATEGORY

Convince our jury that your illustration style belongs in the tschutti heftli scrapbook with your illustration style. The illustration competition is all about the European Women's Championship 2025 The task

Create a **portrait of Lara Dickenmann**, a pioneer and one of Switzerland's greatest female footballers. Her successes include five Swiss championship titles, in Germany and France she won a total of ten championship titles with VFL Wolfsburg and with Olympique Lyon.

She also won the Champions League twice with this team.

The technique of that portrait is absolutely free. Whether 2-D or 3-D, colour or monochrome, digital or analogue, painted, glued or drawn, it doesn't matter.

Children and young people born in 2011 or later, design a portrait of their favourite female football player.

MAIN COMPETITION

The winners will get the chance to design a football team for Euro 2025 and thus become part of our legendary collector's album.

The winners will also be invited to the album release in Lucerne in spring 2025.

CATEGORY U13

The jury will select eleven works from all submissions, which will be printed on a sticker and become part of the 2025 collector's album. You will also receive a complete album with your and all other stickers.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

MAIN COMPETITION

The jury of experts from the fields of sport and art will select the 16 winners from the works submitted. They will be directly commissioned to design a team (eleven player portraits plus coach, crest and your self-portrait) for our album in their own style.

In addition to other personalities, Lara Dickenmann herself will also be on the jury to judge the work. The judging will take place at the end of November 2024. The winners will be notified personally by 1 December 2024 and published on our channels. The winners will have from the beginning of December 2024 to the end of January 2025 to realise the 14 images for the album.

CATEGORY U13

The jury of experts from the fields of sport and art will select the eleven best works from all the portraits submitted. The winners will be notified personally by the end of October 2021 at the latest and published on our channels.

CLOSING DATE

FORMAT

Digital as PDF or JPG, minimum format DIN A4 at 300 dpi.

TECHNIQUE

All realisation techniques are permitted as long as no copyrights are not infringed.

A brief description of the of the technique and tools used is mandatory.

(Description in the e-mail text.) All works must be digitised, three-dimensional works must be photographed. Analogue submissions by post cannot be considered.

SUBMISSIONS

By e-mail to contest@tschuttiheft.li Each participant is only allowed one submission (in the case of multiple submissions only one will be selected and admitted to the competition). A confirmation of participation will be sent by e-mail within one week. Declaration of consent By submitting an entry, participants automatically agree to design a team for the collector's album if they are selected. The advertised prize money will only be paid out if the winners design a team for the collector's album. Furthermore, the participants declare that their work does not infringe any third-party copyrights.

USE

tschutti heftli receives a temporally, spatially and objectively unrestricted and and subject matter and non-exclusive right of use to the submitted work (including the right to modify and copy as well as the right of utilisation). tschutti heftli may use the submitted works for journalistic reporting, self-promotion and their and reproductions thereof in publications or exhibitions.

PRE-SELECTION

In the event of a very large number of submissions, tschutti heftli reserves the right to send the jury a pre-selected selection based on qualitative criteria.

No correspondence will be entered into regarding the competition.

Legal recourse is excluded.
